SALINI IMPREGILO SEARCHES FOR YOUNG TALENT FOR MAJOR INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

THE GROUP TAKES PART IN BOCCONI & JOBS EVENT AT BOCCONI UNIVERSITY IN MILAN

MILAN, November 5, 2019 – Salini Impregilo today takes part in the 32nd edition of the “Bocconi & Jobs” career day at Milan’s Bocconi University where students can get information and discover career opportunities offered by the Group. Its participation at the event is part of the Employer Branding Salini Impregilo initiative to attract young talent and other professionals who could eventually represent the Group’s best assets in the future.

The Employer Branding Salini Impregilo initiative, conducted mostly on university campuses, lends support to the Group’s strategy of positioning itself on international markets. In the last three years, it has seen Salini Impregilo take part in more than 180 events. For example, Salini Impregilo has been a “Partner for Development” at Bocconi University since 2015, and it has collaborated with a network of top universities including the University of Technology Sydney in Australia. Other projects it supports include the Master’s in International Construction Management, which reached its third edition at the Politecnico di Milano university.

All of this emphasises investing in a new generation of professionals to help the Group respond the challenges of the future. Today, 27% of Salini Impregilo staff is aged under 30 years. Meanwhile, 45% is below 35 years. This type of investment is destined to increase under Progetto Italia, the industrial operation launched by Salini Impregilo to consolidate the fragmented infrastructure sector in Italy, underlining the Group’s commitment to make the most of the sector’s levels of excellence to compete on world markets.

Salini Impregilo’s commitment to young people has seen it receive a “Best Employer of Choice” award for a third year in a row in 2019. The award, based on a survey by a consultancy, demonstrates how Salini Impregilo is one of the attractive places to work in Italy for young people, especially among science and engineering students and graduates.

Salini Impregilo is one of the major global players in the construction of large, complex civil infrastructure. For five years it has been ranked No. 1 in the water infrastructure sector by Engineering News-Record (ENR) and as of 2018 has achieved ranking in the Top Ten of the Top Environmental Firms. It is also a leader in the transport infrastructure sector, being involved in major sustainable mobility projects in rail and metro systems around the world. It has successfully built some of the world’s most iconic projects: bridges, roads and motorways, civil and industrial buildings, and airports. The Group has 113 years of engineering experience on five continents, with design, engineering and construction operations in nearly 50 countries and more than 35,000 employees from over 100 nationalities. It is a signatory of the United Nations Global Compact as it pursues the sustainable development goals of its clients, from clean water and energy to sustainable mobility to buildings with a low environmental impact. Its expertise is displayed in projects such as the Grand Paris Express metro system, Cityringen in Copenhagen, Sydney Metro Northwest, Red Line North Underground in Doha and Line 3 of the Riyadh Metro. Other projects include the expansion of the Panama Canal, the Rogun hydroelectric dam in Tajikistan, the Anacostia River and Northeast Boundary tunnels in Washington, D.C. and the Al Bayt 2022 World Cup stadium in Qatar. In 2018, new orders totalled €6.0 billion, with a total backlog reaching €33.4 billion. Salini Impregilo Group is headquartered in Italy and is listed on the Milan Stock Exchange (Borsa Italiana: SAL; Reuters: SALI.MI; Bloomberg: SAL:IM).
