WEBUILD: A "SOLIDARITY PROJECT SITE" WITH THE COMMUNITY OF SANT'EGIDIO (COMUNITA' DI SANT'EGIDIO). 20,000 FOOD PACKAGES BEING DISTRIBUTED THROUGHOUT ITALY TO HELP PEOPLE IN NEED

Milan, December 22, 2021 - A "special construction site" has taken shape during this festive season thanks to the solidarity project with Webuild alongside the Community of Sant'Egidio (*Comunità di Sant'Egidio*): Solidarity activities for the less fortunate, consisting in the distribution of 20 thousand food packages to people in need, in 6 of the main Italian cities: from north to south, islands included. The packages will consist of basic foodstuffs, traditional Christmas products, and certified protective masks. A small gesture to help achieve the first of the Sustainable Development Goals: "No Poverty".

Christmas lunch with the poor is a traditional appointment for the Community of Sant'Egidio (*Comunità di Sant'Egidio*), which is confirmed, in different ways, despite the difficulties linked to the pandemic. 14,000 food packages will be sent to central and southern Italy, including Rome, Naples, Catania and Palermo. A further 6,000, will be distributed between Milan and Genoa. A big and virtual Christmas table, for an inclusive Christmas that excludes no one.

For Webuild, this collaboration with the Community of Sant'Egidio (*Comunità di Sant'Egidio*) is a tangible demonstration of the Group's commitment and social role, a daily role in the areas where it works.

Webuild, the new group born in 2020 from Salini Impregilo, is a leading global player in the construction of large, complex projects for sustainable mobility, clean hydro energy, clean water, green buildings, supporting clients in achieving sustainable development goals (SDGs). The Group is the expression of 115 years of engineering experience applied in 50 countries, on five continents, with 70,000 direct and indirect employees, from over 100 nationalities. Recognized for five years by Engineering News-Record (ENR) as the world leader in water infrastructure (such as dams, hydraulic tunnels, water and wastewater management, and water treatment and desalination plants), it ranks since 2018 among the top 10 in the environment sector. It also leads the sustainable mobility sector (especially metro and rail lines, in addition to roads and bridges). In 2020, the Group's total order backlog reached €41.7 billion, with 89% of the backlog of construction orders involving projects supporting the SDGs set by the United Nations. Webuild, subject to direction and coordination by Salini Costruttori SpA, is headquartered in Italy and is listed on the Milan Stock Exchange (Borsa Italiana: WBD; Reuters: WBD.MI; Bloomberg: WBD:IM).
