Sustainability, culture and innovation on the same line

Line C unites the past and the future of Rome. It connects the centre to the periphery along a 26-km route to transport hundreds of thousands of people every day. It balances the needs of sustainable mobility with the promotion of Rome's historical heritage thanks to the archaeostation: a series of museums that connect the main cultural areas of the city along a route that is full of archaeological discoveries made during the excavations.
